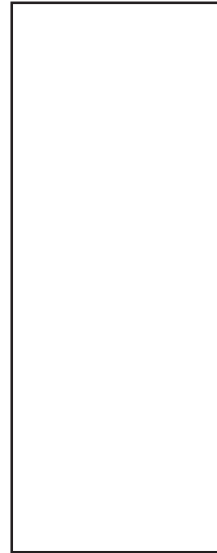

CAREERS 2006

The Illinois School for the Deaf (ISD) is offering a Career Exploration Camp for students who are deaf or hard of hearing. ISD is located on a 55 acre campus in Jacksonville, Illinois and has excellent facilities with a comprehensive educational program, a swimming pool and two weight lifting rooms. The camp is limited to the first 30 students in grades 9 to 12 to apply. Campers will live in dormitories with two to a room on the ISD campus, eat meals in the cafeteria and attend classes in the ISD Career Technical Education Center. The camp will open on Sunday, June 18th after 1:00 p.m. and close at 3:00 p.m. on Friday, June 23rd.

GOAL

The camp's goal is to provide the campers the opportunity to explore careers, improving communication and socialization skills through an exposure to course work in Career Exploration, Graphic Design, Web Design and TV Production.

Deadline for applying for the camp is April 28, 2006.

CAMP ACTIVITIES

Courses will be taught in two hour blocks and will give students an opportunity to have hands on experiences in the courses. Various recreational activities will be offered during the evenings. An awards program will be held on Friday, June 23rd.



FEE/COST

There is a \$10.00 fee to cover the cost of a camp t-shirt. Students should also bring \$20 spending money.

APPLICATION

Parents must complete an application prior to April 28, 2006. If an application is not included with this brochure, fill out the form on the next page and send it to Christine Good at ISD.

TRANSPORTATION

ISD will provide free transportation for campers coming to camp on June 18th if parents have previously requested it on the application. Parents may bring their students to the school after 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 18th. Parents must pick up their students at 3:00 p.m. on June 23rd.
