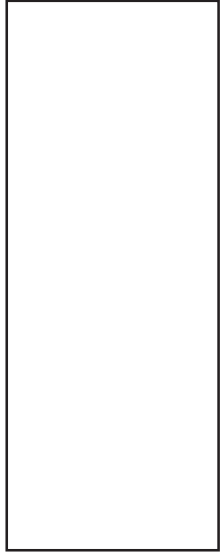

The Illinois School for the Deaf (ISD) is offering a sports camp for children who are deaf or hard of hearing. ISD is located on a 55 acre campus in Jacksonville, Illinois and has excellent facilities with two regulation-size basketball courts, a swimming pool and two weight lifting rooms. The camp is limited to the first 30 children in grades 5 to 8 to apply. Campers will live in dormitories with two to a room on the ISD campus, eat meals in the cafeteria and practice in one of ISD's two gymnasiums. The camp will open on Sunday, June 18nd after 1:00 p.m. and close at 3:00 p.m. on Friday, June 23rd.

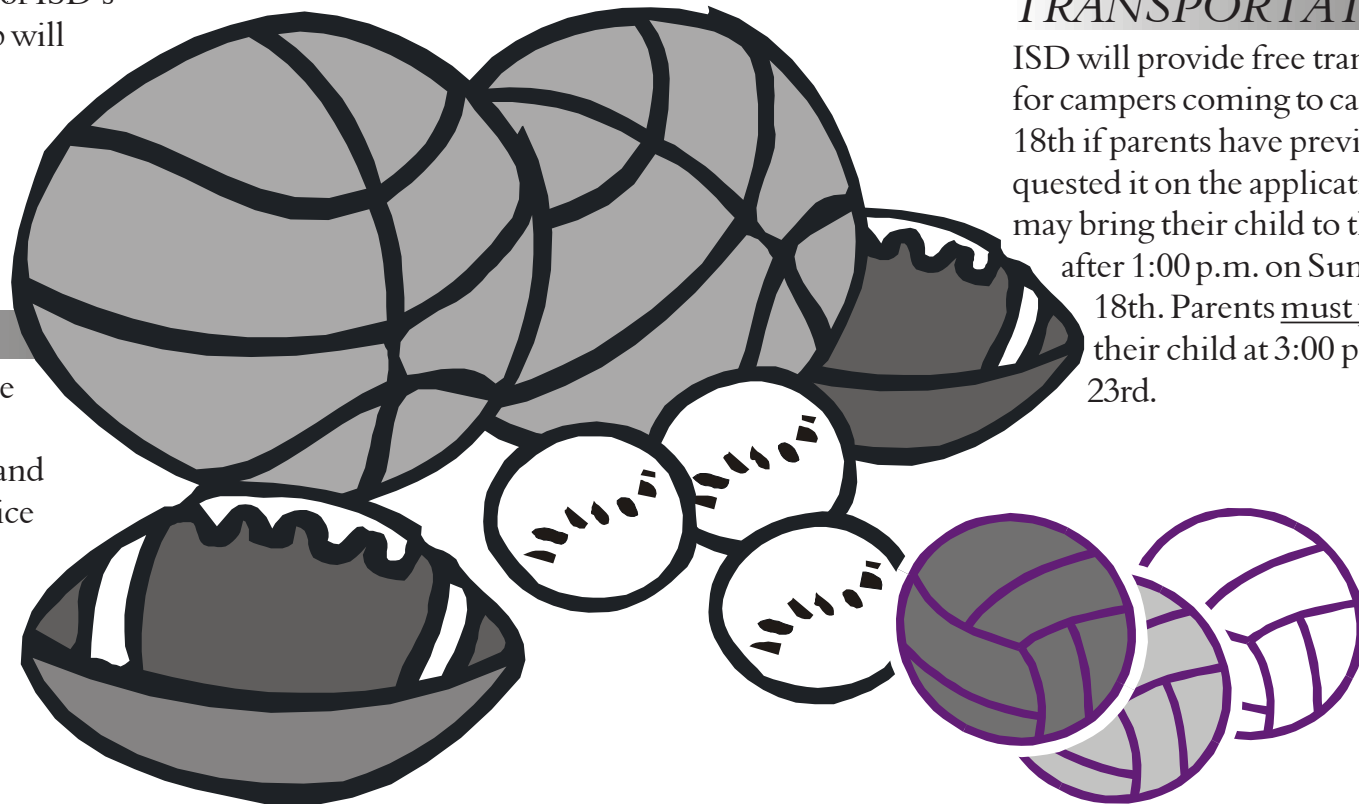
GOAL

The camp's goal is to provide the campers the opportunity to improve communication and socialization skills and practice good sportsmanship while improving their skills in various games and activities.

Deadline for applying for the camp is April 28, 2006.

CAMP ACTIVITIES

A new sport or game will be introduced each day. Campers will spend the mornings and afternoons receiving specific skill instruction and participating in the activity of the day. Various recreational activities will be offered during the evenings. An awards program will be held on Friday, June 23rd.



FEE/COST

There is a \$10.00 fee to cover the cost of a camp t-shirt. Children should also bring \$20 spending money.

APPLICATION

Parents must complete an application prior to April 28, 2006. If an application is not included with this brochure, fill out the form on the next page and send it to Wendy Daniel at ISD.

TRANSPORTATION

ISD will provide free transportation for campers coming to camp on June 18th if parents have previously requested it on the application. Parents may bring their child to the school after 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 18th. Parents must pick up their child at 3:00 p.m. on June 23rd.
